Tuition

Tuition is due on the 1st lesson of each month. When absent– please notify the studio. Make up classes are recommended. **THERE IS NO CREDIT FOR MISSED LESSONS.** Check or Cash only (a \$20.00 fee will be charged for NSF. A late registration fee of \$30.00 will be charged for students who enroll after October 30th . Re-enrollment fee of \$25.00 will be charged for any student who has been absent for 4 consecutive classes and has not paid.

Dress Code

Dress codes are an important part of dance training. Not surprisingly, teachers love the simple., unadorned look a dress code brings. Not only can we see what is going on with your alignment better, we believe your personality should shine through your work, not through your wardrobe. Students enrolled in Classical Ballet must wear a solid colored black leotard, pink or suntan tights and pink Capezio or Bloch ballet shoes. Pants or shorts are not permitted for Ballet. Hair should be secured neatly off the neck. Cecchetti students must wear solid black leotard, pink tights, and hair in a bun.

Preschool children may wear pink or black leotards and black tap shoes.

School age children (5yrs– and up) should have tan tap shoes. Consult your teacher if in question about styles of tap or jazz shoes. Please be sure to label all dance shoes clearly with student's name
